



## DRBCCC HINDU COLLEGE - FDP – IQAC – CHRIST UNIVERSITY

### DAY ONE REPORT – 12-6-23 – 10 am – 1 pm

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of DRBCCC Hindu College in collaboration with Christ (Deemed to be University) Bangalore conducted a five-day faculty development programme for the faculty members from the 12<sup>th</sup> of June to 16<sup>th</sup> of June 2023. The venue for the event was the Cunnan Conference Hall. The sessions were scheduled from 10 am – 1 pm on all the five days.

In the inaugural session of the five-day faculty programme, Dr. K. Sridhar, IQAC / NAAC Co-ordinator, DRBCCC Hindu College, welcomed the members of the faculty and the dignitaries. Sri M. Venkatesaperumal garu, the Honorary Secretary, of DRBCCC Hindu College delivered the inaugural address. In his address, the Honorary Secretary highlighted the importance of the faculty development programmes and added that the faculty members should transform themselves into life-long learners. Dr. N Rajendra Naidu, Director, Center for Research and Development gave the special address. In his speech, the Director said that if a teacher is well-read and well-informed, it will have a great impact on the learning experience of the students. Dr. S Veeramani, the Principal-in-charge, spoke about the need to have an open-mindedness with regards to professional development of the faculty. Dr. C Karpagavalli, Head of the Department of English (Shift 2) served as the emcee for the Day 1 of the FDP.

Dr. John Joseph Kennedy, Dean, School of Arts and Humanities, Christ (Deemed to be University) Bangalore was the resource person for the first day of the five-day Faculty Development Programme. He spoke on the topic 'Effective Communication and Presentation Skills for Teachers'. He started the session by talking about the growth



mindset that a teacher should possess to imbibe and assimilate new ideas. Quoting the famous lines of Alvin Toffler, he said that the illiterate of the 21<sup>st</sup> century will be the ones who cannot learn, unlearn, and relearn. He remarked that the primary objective of communication is to build relationships. Communication enhances the professional bonding between individuals. He told the members of the faculty that they should be sincere in their communication and words and non-verbal cues should flow from their heart. An effective communicator will always respect and

value the opinion of the other. A good communicator will also be good listener. Communication can happen even without exchanging a single word or sentence. 90% of the communication that happens is non-verbal. Communication is essential not just for the personal / professional development of the individual but also for the development of the organisation. The resource person briefly touched upon the barriers which prevents effective communication from



happening. Dr. John Joseph Kennedy with the help of an infographic explained the three types of communication patterns i.e. – Passive, Assertive and Aggressive. He suggested that a good communicator will always be assertive. Using some interesting examples, he illustrated the dangers of

miscommunication. Dr. John Joseph Kennedy made the session an interactive one by asking volunteers to come forward to participate in dumb charades and do a group activity based on listening for instructions.

Dr. John Joseph Kennedy, spoke about how the ambiguous sentences can lead to confusion in communication. He also spoke about how Semantics and Pragmatics play a huge role in



communication. He ended the session by distributing useful handouts to the participants for improving their listening skills. He said that active listening plays a key role in the communication process. Dr C. Karpagavalli thanked the resource for the informative session. Lunch was served in the college canteen for all the participants of the FDP.

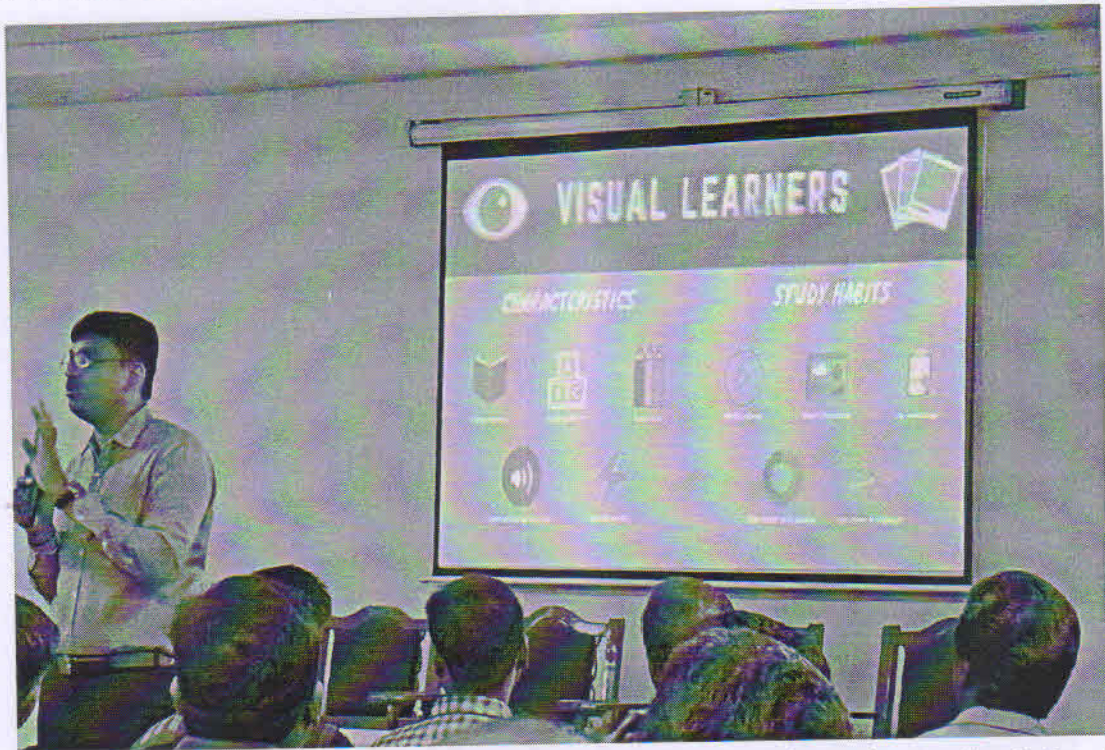
### DAY TWO REPORT – 13-6-23 – 10 am – 1 pm

The topic for the second day of the five-day FDP event organized by DRBCCC Hindu College in association with Christ University Bangalore was 'Managing a Blended Teaching Classroom'. The resource person for Day two was Dr. Vinay M, Associate Professor & Programme Co-ordinator, Department of Computer Science, Co-ordinator, Office of Online Training and Examination, Christ, Deemed to be University, Yeshwantpura Campus, Bengaluru. Dr. Vinay began his session by referring to the online learning in the classroom before COVID, during COVID and after COVID. He spoke about the rapid advancements that are



being made in technology driven teaching and learning methods where MS Dhoni can appear before us as a hologram projection and teach you how to play the helicopter shot. Today's students are born into the world of technology. Dr. Vinay exhorted all the members of faculty to upgrade themselves with the latest digital tools and gadgets so that they can stay one step ahead of the students. He suggested that what teachers deliver in the classroom should be based on something that is not available in the internet. Only then the classroom learning will be a productive one. He defined blended learning as a combination of the black board and the screen. Blended learning will enable the students to learn beyond the classroom (asynchronous learning)

Dr. Vinay told the faculty members to assess their students in the first few sessions. He explained in detail the three types of students – Visual, Auditory and Kinaesthetic learners. Once the students are grouped into these three categories, the teacher can create digital teaching content based on the level of the students. This is also important for the Outcome Based Learning which is a part of the UGC requirements. He suggested that the digital tools should be used only deciding on the learning activity. After the tea break, Dr Vinay gave a



demo of the interactive game developed by Google to teach students about the four important tenets of Digital Safety which are Smart, Alert, Brave and Kind ( Share with Care, Don't Fall for Fake, Secure your Secrets and It is cool to be kind) He also introduced various digital tools like Google Workspace, Flippity, Coggleit, Book Creator, Raptivity, Screen Castify, SciSpace Copilot etc.

**DAY THREE REPORT – 14-6-23 – 10 am – 1 pm**

The third day of the five-day faculty development programme organized by the IQAC of DRBCCC Hindu College witnessed the interactive session by Dr. Greta D'Souza, Associate Professor, Head School of Education – Christ (deemed to be university) Bangalore. The topic for the third day was – 'Competencies of Effective Teachers'.



Dr Greta began her session by asking everyone to reflect on COVID-19 teaching experience. To drive home the point of teacher competency she distributed newspaper cuttings to all the faculty members and asked them to use it to teach an activity in an imaginary classroom. The purpose behind this activity was to demonstrate was to reflect on the ways a teacher can add more information to the already loaded mind of a student. She said that every teacher should have a mastery over the content and apply various pedagogical strategies to maximise learning in the classroom. Teachers are expected to show compassion and empathy towards the students. Mentoring is one method by which this can be achieved. A teacher should also make sure that the 17 sustainable goals as prescribed by UNESCO are imparted to the students. Dr Greta spoke about the core competencies of a teacher which included content knowledge, pedagogical expertise, classroom management, differentiation, and individualization. She underlined the importance of communication skills and the importance to collaborate with colleagues and stake holders. She recommended rubric based assessment for students.



Dr Greta wanted to have differentiated learning methods employed in the classroom to serve both the high achievers and low achievers. She preferred to call the low achievers as emerging learners and high achievers as refined learners. Dr Greta provided the faculty members three methods to make the classroom assessment and engagement more meaningful and productive. The three methods are Cubing, Tic- Tac- Toe and the Menu approach. She ended her session by providing some online resources for the teachers.

**DAY FOUR REPORT – 15-6-23 – 10 am – 1 pm**

Dr. John J Kennedy, Dean, Arts and Science was the resource person for the fourth day of the five-day Faculty Development Programme organized by DRBCCC Hindu College in collaboration with Christ, (Deemed to be University) He presented his ideas based on the topic – Leadership and Student Management. He had titled his PowerPoint presentation as 'Building Faculty Teams that Matter'. He said that every teacher is a leader, and they are responsible for moulding the future leaders of the nation. He began his session by reviewing the activity which was introduced on Monday (June 12, 2023) when he handled the session on the topic – Effective Communication.



Using the activity as the background he underlined the fact that each teacher is unique in his/her own capabilities and approaches to teaching. There are many common elements of teaching but there are also variations in teaching styles. Dr Joseph Kennedy said that the students should be studied / diagnosed before commencing the teaching sessions. He used this quote to drive home the point 'Doing is not enough, we must do it well, Doing well is not enough, we must do it consistently well'. He spoke about the three essential steps of teaching – filtering of information, converting the same into knowledge and develop teaching competencies based on that. He also made it clear that we don't use the acronym SWOT these days, but it is changed to SWOC. Self-assessment is an important quality of a leader, and he/she should do this keeping in mind the three important characteristics of teaching – Cognitive. Affective and Behavioural. All teachers should operate on these three levels. The resource person differentiated between the two words - hierarchic and hierarchical. He said that the teacher is no more an information agent but an agent of change. He said that the values cannot be taught but can only be demonstrated. In today's academia, a teacher plays multiple roles which include teaching, researching, administrative work, guiding research scholars, mentoring, and coaching.

The three competencies required by a teacher include, diagnosing, adapting, and communicating. These are the basic qualities of a successful academic leader. A leader should have a sense of purpose and vision. He should also possess a shared understanding of the goals of the organisation. A teacher leader is constantly engaged in building the future of his/her students and the country. The teacher should follow the rules of the organisation, he/she should not grumble because the organization will never change its rules for a single individual. Quoting the Lebanese poet Khalil Gibran's work, Dr John J Kennedy said that teaching is based on reciprocation. Students should reciprocate to the ideas and concepts presented in the classroom. Leadership is based on contingency or emergency and a leader should immediately take steps to address the problems. He/ she is endowed with a repertoire of practices and methods and the right method should be used to solve the problem. The leadership style is based on the context and the cultural needs of the population.

He used the short video of Jack Welch CEO of GE to demonstrate that a leader should be – Chief Meaning Officer, Chief Brooming Officer, and Chief Fun Officer. He ended the session by distributing handouts to the faculty members which contained self-assessment questions, and a few case studies related to teaching and leadership.

**DRBCCC HINDU COLLEGE - FDP – IQAC – CHRIST UNIVERSITY**  
**DAY FIVE REPORT – 16-6-23 – 10 am – 1 pm**

The final day of the five-day FDP event organized by the IQAC of DRBCCC Hindu College in partnership with Christ (deemed to be University), Bengaluru saw, Dr. Joseph Kennedy, the Director of Center for Education Beyond Curriculum speaking on the topic – ‘Research Integrated Teaching’ (RIT) . According to Dr Kennedy, research outcomes should ultimately influence the curriculum designing process. He also underlined that there is a need to create research integrated teaching culture in the campus. There is also the need to create a localized branding based on the location of the Higher Education institution. He exhorted the assembled teaching fraternity to have a purpose oriented teaching methods. It is one of the essential quality for both teaching and research. Dr. Kennedy defined research as something that emerges because of team effort and collaboration. He opined that research



would lead to

innovation and novelty. He stated that teaching and research are two sides of the same coin. Dr Kennedy made some well-informed comments on the NEP and stated that there will be two types of Universities under the National Education Framework. One will be Research Centered Universities and the other one will Teaching Centered Universities.

Dr Kennedy spoke about the importance of evidence based research which borders on experience and tacit knowledge. In this context he highlighted the importance of SUPW – Socially Useful Productive Work aka Service Learning. This is one of the prime examples of experiential learning. The teacher is totally responsible for designing the learning

environment. The ideal classroom should be driven by students and learning should be a self-directed activity. Educators should be part of a community of inquirers. Their role is to investigate the truth and define the reality. This should be done collectively for the sake of pursuit of knowledge or data. The community of inquirers should become agents of facilitation, knowledge constructors, validators, and independent research entities.

In his three hour long speech, Dr. Joseph Kennedy suggested that the college start a Journal club to make the publication process more popular and efficient. Publication will bring respectability to the institution and to the individual teacher. He said that the art of research can start at the departmental level involving research paper presentation, conducting research scholar colloquiums, and providing opportunities for publishing. Dr Kennedy reminded everyone that there a fine balance between research and teaching should be maintained. Towards the end of the session, Dr Kennedy spoke about the various *theories* involved in research and teaching including the four ways of experiencing RIT – the Transmitter, the Detective, the Catalyst, the Agent, and the Wayfarer.
